Since 2006, the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) has used a variety of Niagara Therapy equipment within the Recovery Centre onsite at the AIS, remotely with a range of sports, and throughout the last three Paralympic Game cycles.

The AIS Recovery Centre has a series of six Niagara CVT Therapy Chairs, as well as several portable vibration devices, all approved by the Therapeutic Goods Administration as Class 11a Medical Devices.
